PERMANENT, FULL-TIME STAFF POSITION

Calgary Laboratory Services (CLS) and The Department of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine invite applications for a full-time Laboratory Director for its HPC Processing Laboratory. This modern facility is fully accredited by FACT and serves as the sole processing & cryo-preservation laboratory for one of the largest Bone Marrow Transplant Programs in Canada (about 180 Auto & Allo transplants annually). The successful candidate will be accountable for overseeing the routine operation, quality assurance/improvement and maintenance of accreditation. The Laboratory Director will play a leading role in development of new techniques through extensive collaborative/independent research in the field of stem cell manipulation & graft enhancement utilizing BMT experimental models. Duties will also include post-graduate teaching and representing HPC Laboratory at Alberta Bone Marrow Transplant Program.

CLS is a multi-site, regionalized laboratory providing comprehensive laboratory services to the Calgary Health Region. The Department of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine is part of the rapidly growing Faculty of Medicine and significant opportunities exist for participation in teaching and research. Calgary is a vibrant, multicultural city near the Rocky Mountains, Banff National Park and Lake Louise.

Qualifications include PhD in biological sciences complemented by a minimum of three years of postdoctoral experience (related to stem cell collection, preservation and or manipulation); including minimum of one-year experience in HPC laboratory. Preference will be given to candidates with working experience in a FACT accredited facility. Applicants with a MD with appropriate clinical graduate training will also be considered.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Calgary Laboratory Services respects, appreciates and encourages diversity.
