

Internationally Trained Candidates

If you have received Training and/or Education outside of Canada you are required to obtain a certificate or assessment which validates that your training is equivalent to that offered in Canada as per the position requirements.

Education and Training assessments for Alberta are completed by the <u>International</u> <u>Qualifications Assessment Service (IQAS)</u>. Please visit their website for more information on services, pricing and processing times.

If your Education and/or Training has previously been assessed within Canada by another assessment office, Calgary Laboratory Services is able to accept the assessment only if the office was one of the federally recognized <u>Alliance of Credential Evaluation Services of Canada (ACESC)</u>.

If your Training and/or Education are deemed not equivalent to Canadian credentials for a particular position you must obtain the applicable Canadian credentials in order to be qualified to work at Calgary Laboratory Services.

Internationally Trained Medical Laboratory Assistant

In order to be eligible to work at Calgary Laboratory Services as a Medical Laboratory Assistant (MLA) you must hold an MLA Certificate from an Educational Institute within Canada satisfactory to CLS. If you have received International Training as a Medical Laboratory Assistant you are able to apply for MLA Certification through the <u>Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS)</u>.
