### **LOCUM POSITIONS**

The Department of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine and Calgary Laboratory Services (CLS) invite applications for locum Anatomic Pathologist positions.

Two positions are available to address a short-term need. The period of appointment is negotiable, but terms from 1-3 months are preferred.

Locum coverage may be required at one of three academic teaching hospitals in Calgary. Foothills Medical Centre (FMC) deals with a broad spectrum of tertiary care work, including transplantation biopsies. Regional autopsy services and Neuropathology Services are consolidated at this centre. The Peter Lougheed Centre (PLC) has an emphasis on gynecologic and gastrointestinal pathology, while the Rockyview General Hospital (RGH) has an emphasis on urologic and breast pathology.

CLS is a multi-site, regionalized laboratory providing comprehensive laboratory services to the Calgary Health Region. CLS processes >100,000 surgical specimens and >220,000 cytology specimens annually. The Department of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine is part of the rapidly growing Faculty of Medicine. Calgary is a vibrant, multicultural city near the Rocky Mountains, Banff National Park and Lake Louise.

Qualifications include a MD, eligibility for licensure in the Province of Alberta, and certification in Anatomic Pathology.

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Calgary Laboratory Services and the University of Calgary respects, appreciates and encourages diversity
