



Special Arrangement for Neonatal Bilirubin Collection

Instructions for Parents

Neonatal Bilirubin collection outside of regular hours at RGH or ACH Outpatient Laboratories

Your doctor has ordered a stat bilirubin blood test on your baby, which can be collected at any Calgary Laboratory Services Patient Service Center (PSC). Please refer to the CLS website for PSC locations and hours of operation:

At the PSC, line up for the reception desk and tell the laboratory staff that your doctor has ordered a stat bilirubin collection on your baby.

<p>Directions to the laboratory:</p> <p>Use the main hospital entrance and take elevators to 3rd floor.</p> <p>Look for “CLS Outpatient Lab” sign and go to the Specimen Reception window, two doors to the right of the CLS outpatient lab.</p>	<p>Directions to the laboratory:</p> <p>Use the main entrance and proceed around the gift shop to the lab. Look for “Laboratory” sign hanging above the door.</p> <p>Use phone on opposite wall to call CLS Accession Department at local 38747.</p>
<p>Tell the laboratory staff this is a special arrangement for stat neonatal bilirubin collection. You will be served as soon as possible.</p>
